How to use this chart:

Acceptance Ratios are shown by Overall Application GPA (listed on the top row) and the Medical College Admissions Test (MCAT) (listed in the column at the left). The most recent MCAT score is used in case of multiple test dates. The ratio reflects the number acceptances out of the total number of applicants within that section. For example, in the 2012 application year, 27 UCLA seniors applied with a GPA of 3.90 or higher combined with an MCAT score of 35 or higher. Of those 27 applicants, 25 of them (or 93%) were accepted into at least one medical school.

Note: The reported information is drawn from the American Association of Medical Colleges, 2012 and based solely on students who give permission to share data. Therefore, not all 2012 graduates who applied are represented.
